FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW NO. 805, 2022

A Bylaw of the Corporation of the Village of McBride to impose fees and charges.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Community Charter* and *Local Government Act* Council may, by bylaw impose a fee or charge;

AND WHERAS Council deems it desirable to consolidate fees and charges within a single bylaw for convenience;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of McBride, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 - Introduction

1.1 Title

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Village of McBride Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 805, 2022".

1.2 Definitions

Unless otherwise defined herein, all words and phrases in this Bylaw shall have the meaning given to them in the *Local Government Act* and the *Community Charter*. In this Bylaw:

"Village" means the Corporation of the Village of McBride.

1.3 Severability

If any section, subsection, clause, sub-clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, that section, subsection, clause, sub-clause or phrase shall be struck from the Bylaw and any decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw.

Section 2 – Fees and Charges
