

# 2026 Permissive Tax Exemptions Applications

The Village of McBride is now accepting applications for 2026 Permissive Tax Exemptions. Section 224 of the Community Charter gives Council the authority to exempt certain land and /or improvements from municipal property taxes. Council considers Permissive Tax Exemptions for non-profit organizations that contribute to the well-being of Village residents and/or that make improvements to the quality of life for residents.

To be eligible for a permissive tax exemption, an organization must comply with the guidelines as per Community Charter Section 224, <u>Property Qualified for Permissive Tax Exemptions</u> and be approved by Council.

The deadline for applications to be received by the Village Office is Thursday, September 18, 2025 at 12:00 noon.

Please contact the Village Office for an application at 100 Robson Centre, 855 SW Frontage Road, McBride, BC.

Note: Organizations currently included in Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 831, 2024 will receive exemptions for a ten-year period, beginning in 2025 and ending in 2034.
